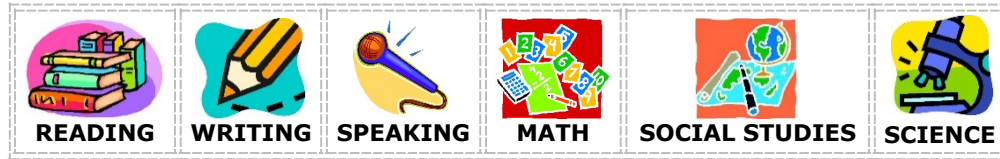


FIFTH GRADE STANDARDS
