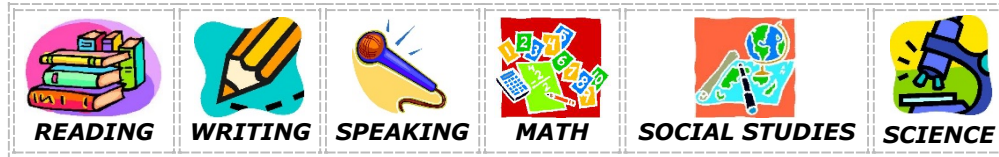


FOURTH GRADE STANDARDS
